All students complete a 70 hour community service requirement as well as a 36-hour senior job shadowing project.

Notre Dame Academy is a selective, private, college-preparatory school for young women in grades 7-12. Our student body of 562 girls are from a wide range of economic and ethnic backgrounds. Notre Dame Academy is an International Baccalaureate World School that offers both a full diploma and certificate program. An extensive honors and Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum offers courses in Mathematics, Science, Theology, Language Arts, World Languages, and Social Studies. A detailed course catalog is available online at www.nda.org. Notre Dame Academy allows students to participate in the College Credit Plus program (off campus). Students can usually take no more than three CCP courses per semester.

Notre Dame Academy operates on a block schedule consisting of four 79-minute classes meeting every other day. Notre Dame Academy does not participate in the National Honor Society.

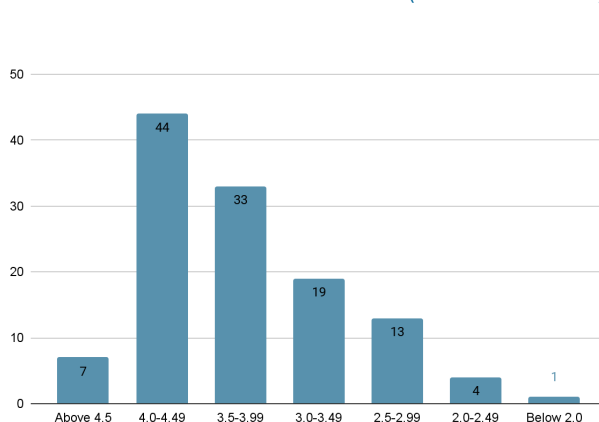

Grading Scale

Notre Dame Academy uses a weighted 4.0 GPA scale. An extra weight of 1.0 is given to grades of C- or higher in AP or IB courses. An extra weight of 0.5 is given to grades of C- or higher in honors courses. Explanation of the grading scale is located on students' transcripts. NDA does not provide an exact class rank.

Class of 2024 Statistics

- 136 seniors graduated in May of 2024.
- Earned \$19 million in college scholarships.
- Accepted to 132 different colleges and universities.
- 95% attended a 4-year college.

International Baccalaureate

In 2024, 5 out of 5 full-diploma candidates received the IB diploma. 97 students (71%) in the class of 2024 pursued IB coursework. 86% scored a 4 or higher on the IB tests.

Advanced Placement

In 2024, 194 AP tests were given at NDA in English Literature & Composition (25), Psychology (46), Environmental Science (47), US History (1), Calculus AB (14), Computer Science Principles (5), Human Geography (51), Macroeconomics (1), Microeconomics (1), Statistics (2), and Physics (1). 71% scored a 3 or higher (33% scored a 3, 45% scored a 4, and 22% scored a 5).
