All students complete 70 hours of community service as well as a 12-hour senior job shadowing project for 0.25 credit.

Notre Dame Academy is a selective, private, college-preparatory school for young women in grades 6-12. Our student body of 533 girls are from a wide range of economic and ethnic backgrounds. Notre Dame Academy is an International Baccalaureate World School that offers both a full diploma and certificate program. An extensive honors and Advanced Placement (AP) curriculum offers courses in Mathematics, Science, Theology, Language Arts, World Languages, and Social Studies. A detailed course catalog is available online at www.nda.org. Notre Dame Academy allows students to participate in the College Credit Plus (CCP) program off campus. Students can usually take no more than two CCP courses per semester due to rigorous course scheduling at Notre Dame Academy.

Notre Dame Academy operates on a block schedule consisting of four 81-minute classes that meet every other day. Notre Dame Academy does not participate in the National Honor Society.

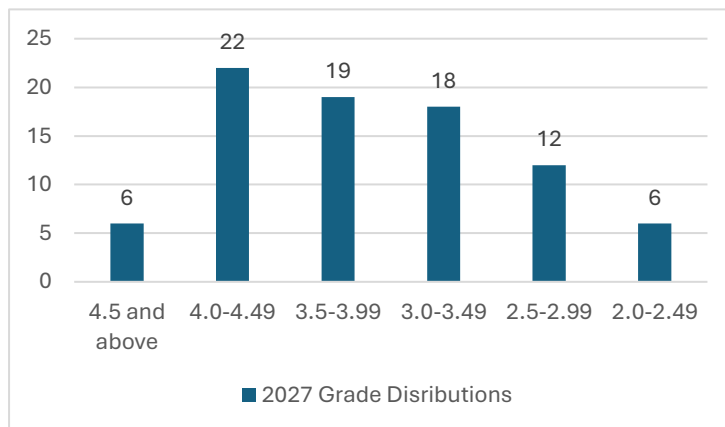

Grading Scale

Notre Dame Academy uses a weighted 4.0 GPA scale. An extra weight of 1.0 is given to grades of C- or higher in AP, IB, or CCP courses. An extra weight of 0.5 is given to grades of C- or higher in honors courses. An explanation of the grading scale is located on students' transcripts. NDA does not provide an exact class rank.

Class of 2026 Statistics

- 119 seniors graduated in May of 2026.

• Earned \$16 million in college scholarships.

• Accepted to 139 different colleges and universities.

• 97% attended a 4-year college.

International Baccalaureate

In 2026, 6 out of 7 full-diploma candidates received the IB diploma. 84 students (71%) in the class of 2026 pursued IB coursework. A total of 212 IB exams were taken in the Spring of 2026 and 79% scored a 4 or higher.

Advanced Placement

In 2026, 110 students took 131 AP tests at NDA in English Literature & Composition (18), Psychology (47), Environmental Science (19), Calculus AB (5), Human Geography (27), Computer Science Principles (2), and US Government (13). 68% scored a 3 or higher (24.5% scored a 3, 27.5% scored a 4, and 16% scored a 5).
