**Margaret:** A small town farmer's wife who dreams of adventure beyond her everyday life. It would be great if the actor could be able to do a Scottish accent. Shy, innocent, and kind.

**Pamela:** The leading lady to the end of the story. Witty, classy, and bold. It would be great if the actor could be able to do a standard British accent.

**Crofter:** Margaret's jealous husband who is very controlling of his wife. It would be great if the actor could be able to do a Scottish accent. Brash, jealous, and skeptical.

**Mr. Memory:** A stage performer who has the ability to recall thousands of facts upon demand. be able to do a British Cockney accent. Compere Mr. Memory's emcee to his act. Loud, outgoing, performative.

**Professor Jordon:** The mysteriously mischievous professor who has the key to what the 39 Steps are. It would be great if the actor could be able to do British accent.

**Radio Announcer:** Must have a radio-style transatlantic accent who reports the latest news on Hannay's criminal status.
