Personal car

Seniors and Juniors are permitted to drive to school. Sophomores may be permitted to drive second semester depending on parking availability, and must contact the Dean of Students for permission to drive. **If your daughter will be driving to school, she will need to complete the online vehicle (available in the summer) registration form and purchase a parking permit.**

If another person drops off your daughter, please make sure they are mindful of adhering to the drop off procedures, which will be discussed at the August parent meeting.

Bus

To arrange for students to ride a bus, parents must request transportation directly to the local public school district of your residence. School districts must receive requests directly from parents in order to place a student on a bus route and will only transport students within their school district.

Each school district is responsible for planning their district's bus route and providing the specific routes to people living in that area. **If you have a bus route question or need to know your daughter's specific bus schedule, please contact your local public school district directly.** Notre Dame Academy does not arrange or decide on any busing for students.

Anthony Wayne Local School District

Transportation is NOT available.

Maumee City School District: 419-893-1392

Transportation NOT available. Maumee offers two options: You may choose to receive reimbursement from Maumee Schools for arranging your own transportation or your daughter may ride TARTA. Please contact Maumee City Schools Transportation Department for details.

Oregon City School District: 419-693-0661, ext. 3284

Transportation is NOT available. Parents are eligible to apply for "payment in lieu of". Requests must contain the parent or guardian's name, home address, student's name and grade, and school the child is attending and its location and be sent to csoncrant@oregoncs.org.

Otsego Local Schools

Transportation is NOT available.

Ottawa Hills Local School District: 419-536-2755

Perrysburg City School District: 419-874-3127

Free yellow bus transportation for those who live in the school district through a co-op with Rossford. Springfield Local School District

Transportation is NOT available. Parents residing in this district are eligible to apply for "payment in lieu of". The form is available at <https://springfield-schools.org> under the transportation menu. Springfield offers payment in lieu for transportation. To receive your reimbursement for the 26-27 school year, you must complete the following form by **June 14th, 2026 at 11:59 pm**. Springfield has recommended that you complete it sooner than later to ensure you will receive the reimbursement.

Swanton Local School District

Transportation is NOT available.

Sylvania City School District: 419-824-8686

Free yellow bus transportation for all those who live in the school district. If you are a City of Toledo tax payer, you are not eligible. **Transportation online request forms will be due May 29th, 2026**. Toledo Public School District: 419-671-8541

TPS works with Trinity Transportation to provide dedicated yellow bus routes that utilize busing to a hub location with transfer to a yellow bus to arrive at school. If you are interested in your student utilizing this to get to/from school, please see the following:

1. If you live in a TPS school district and will be utilizing TPS/Trinity bus transportation for the '26-27 school year, you must complete the TPS Transportation Request Google form found on the tps.org website under the transportation dept menu. (Parochial and Charter Schools)
2. The deadline was **April 1st**. If you missed this date, you should submit the Google form as soon as possible. TPS will not guarantee transportation if you are late in your submission. TPS will make an eligibility decision for your student based on location of both the residence and route location.
3. If eligible, your student will be added to the route roster and assigned a stop. In some cases, a stop location may be moved. For example, if along a route a student is the only rider to be picked up for a mile or more, a stop could be moved at TPS's discretion.
4. If your student is deemed impractical, then a "Payment in Lieu" could be offered.
