

NDA Mobile Device Management (JAMF)

Students and Parents,

During the past two years we have been using our MDM JAMF service on 7th and 8th grade devices. We feel that this service was very successful when creating a restriction profile for these students. This year we are taking it a step further and providing it to our 9th grade devices. Along with Managed Apple IDs this will allow us to create the best learning device for students.

Expanding this to our 9th graders give us more control over their devices. Let's discuss what this service can do:

- Restriction Profile are a great way to build the perfect learning tool.
 - Disabling the use of VPN so that students cannot bypass school network filtering – ensuring their safety on the web.
 - Deferring Software updates to ensure state testing requirements.
 - Requiring a lock pin on the device.
- Device Control
 - We can reset a device remotely if a student is having an issue with it.
 - We can clear the lock pin if the pin is forgotten.
 - We can push updates to the iPad.
 - We can lock the device.
 - We can also reset the device.
- App Control
 - We control the apps that students have access to.
 - The traditional App Store will not be on the device.

While we are happy to take JAMF to the next level we are also encouraging parents to use the “Screen Time” settings on the device. This will give parents even more control of the device.
